Olympic

Organizers of the Paris Olympics marked the two-years-to-go milestone to the 2024 games by unveiling the official slogan - "Games Wide Open" - on Monday and said they got fresh backing from French President Emmanuel Macron for their planned giant opening ceremony along the Seine River.

Mr. Macron held talks in Paris with International Olympic Committee President Thomas Bach and brought together ministers and security officials to review Olympic planning - signaling quickening efforts to ready the French capital for the July 26 to August 11, 2024, games. Breaking with Olympic tradition, the ceremony won't be held inside a stadium and will instead take place on the river that cuts through the French capital.



In Sweden, the dark legacy of 'Saturday candies'


Between 1947 and 1949, the Medical Agency subjected residents of an institution to extreme sugar consumption, an experiment that revealed a causal link with the development of cavities and led to the recommendation to eat sweets only once a week.



Each year, Swedes consume about 15 kg per person, compared to 3.5 kg for a French person.



And for good reason. This habit, which dates back to the 1950s, was recommended by a doctor, Lisa Swenander Lanke, and a dentist, Bo Krasse. Both of them had seen firsthand the damage caused by sugar on teeth and thought it was best to limit the consumption of sucrose to one day a week.





Back to the futur

Back To The Future is an American science fiction film directed by Robert Zemeckis and released in 1985.

The plot recounts the journey into the past of a teenager, Marty McFly, aboard a time machine made by Doctor Emmett Brown, from a DeLorean DMC-12 model car. Leaving the year 1985 and projected on November 5, 1955, Marty, helped by the 1955 «Doc», must solve the temporal paradoxes caused by his interventions in the past, and find a way to make the machine work to return to its time of origin.

THE TRILOGY

While the film was intended as a single film, its commercial success gave rise to two sequels, Back to the Future 2 (1989) and Back to the Future 3 (1990), which formed a trilogy and led to the development of a franchise on various media.

Asterix and Obelix film

Asterix & Obelix: The Middle Kingdom (: Astérix et Obélix: l'Empire du Milieu) is a 2023 French live action adventure comedy family film directed by Guillaume Canet who also stars as Asterix. It is the fifth installment in the Asterix film series. The film, which co-stars Gilles Lelouche as Obelix, sees the title heroes travel to imperial China for the first time. The original story is based on a script by Philippe Mechelen and Julien Hervé. Canet also collaborated on the script. It is the first live-action Asterix film not based on any of the Asterix comic album or starring Gerard Depardieu as Obelix.

Shooting was originally planned to take place in 2020 in China but was delayed for a year and relocated to France due to the COVID19 PANDEMIC ; The film is budgeted at \$72.4 million and is being co-produced by Pathé Les Enfants Terribles and Paris-based Tresor Films. It was released on the 1 February 2023.


William Shakespeare

(bapt. 26 April[b] 1564 – 23 April 1616) was an English playwright, poet and actor. He is widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language and the world's pre-eminent dramatist. He is often called England's national poet and the "Bard of Avon" (or simply "the Bard"). His extant works, including collaborations, consist of some 39 plays,[e] 154 sonnets, three long narrative poems, and a few other verses, some of uncertain authorship. His plays have been translated into every major living language and are performed more often than those of any other playwright.[7] He remains arguably the most influential writer in the English language, and his works continue to be studied and reinterpreted.

Shakespeare produced most of his known works between 1589 and 1613. His early plays were primarily comedies and histories and are regarded as some of the best works produced in these genres. He then wrote mainly tragedies until 1608, among them Hamlet, Romeo and Juliet, Othello, King Lear, and Macbeth, all considered to be among the finest works in the English language. In the last phase of his life, he wrote tragicomedies (also known as romances) and collaborated with other playwrights.

Shakespeare was born and raised in Stratford-upon-Avon, Warwickshire. At the age of 18, he married Anne Hathaway, with whom he had three children: Susanna, and twins Hamnet and Judith. Sometime between 1585 and 1592, he began a successful career in London as an actor, writer, and part-owner of a playing company called the Lord Chamberlain's Men, later known as the King's Men. At age 49 (around 1613), he appears to have retired to Stratford, where he died three years later. Few records of Shakespeare's private life survive; this has stimulated considerable speculation about such matters as his physical appearance, his sexuality, his religious beliefs and whether the works attributed to him were written by others.

Many of Shakespeare's plays were published in editions of varying quality and accuracy in his lifetime. However, in 1623, John Heminges and Henry Condell, two fellow actors and friends of Shakespeare's, published a more definitive text known as the First Folio, a posthumous collected edition of Shakespeare's dramatic works that included all but two of his plays. Its Preface was a prescient poem by Ben Jonson, a former rival of Shakespeare, that hailed Shakespeare with the now famous epithet: "not of an age, but for all time".





dwayne johnson

Johnson was born in Hayward, California on May 2, 1972,[the son of Ata Johnson (née Maivia; born 1948) and former professional wrestler Rocky Johnson (born Wayde Douglas Bowles; 1944–2020).[Growing up, Johnson lived briefly in Grey Lynn in

Auckland, New Zealand with his mother's family, where he played rugby and attended Richmond Road Primary School before returning to the U.S.



Johnson's father was a Black Nova Scotian with a small amount of Irish ancestry. His mother is Samoan. His father and Tony Atlas were the first black tag team champions in WWE history, in 1983. His mother is the adopted daughter of Peter Maivia, who was also a professional wrestler. [38] Johnson's maternal grandmother Lia was one of the first female pro wrestling promoters, taking over Polynesian Pacific Pro Wrestling after her husband's death in 1982 and managing it until 1988. Through his maternal grandfather Maivia, Johnson is a non-blood relative to the Anoa'i wrestling family. In 2008, Johnson inducted his father and grandfather into the WWE Hall of Fame. Johnson attended Montclaire Elementary School in Charlotte, North Carolina before moving to Hamden, Connecticut, where he attended Shepherd Glen Elementary School and then Hamden Middle School. Johnson attended President William McKinley High School in Honolulu and then Glenciff High School and McGavock High School, both in Nashville, and then Freedom High School in Bethlehem Township in the Lehigh Valley, where he graduated in 1990.

THE DEATH OF POP SMOKE

Murdered on Wednesday, February 19, 2020 in Los Angeles, the rapper Pop Smoke died from a gunshot to the chest.



THE POLICE ARE LOOKING INTO TWO POSSIBILITIES, THE ONE OF A ROBBERY GONE WRONG AND THEREFORE OF A NON PREMEDITATED MURDER. BUT ALSO THE HYPOTHESIS OF AN ATTACK LINKED TO A GANG THAT CAN NOT BE EXCLUDED GIVEN THE LINKS BETWEEN THE YOUNG RAPPER AND THE CRIPS GANG. A FEW HOURS BEFORE HIS DEATH, THE RAPPER HAD IN ANY CASE SHARED A VIDEO ON SOCIAL NETWORKS WITH THE EXACT ADDRESS OF THE HOUSE WHERE HE RESIDED, WORTH \$ 2.5 MILLION AND HE RENTED TO THE ACTRESS TEDDI MELLENCAMP.

AFTER AN AUTOPSY ON THE BODY OF 20-YEAR-OLD RAPPER POP SMOKE, THE MEDICAL EXAMINER REVEALED THAT HE DIED FROM A GUNSHOT WOUND TO THE TORSO IN A SHOOTING THAT TOOK PLACE ON FEBRUARY 19 AT A RENTED HOUSE IN THE HOLLYWOOD HILLS IN LOS ANGELES.

After an autopsy on the body of 20-year-old rapper Pop Smoke, the medical examiner revealed that he died from a gunshot wound to the torso in a shooting that took place on February 19 at a rented house in the Hollywood Hills in Los Angeles.

The shooting occurred around 4:30 a.m. in a still unclear setting.

The police are looking into two possibilities, the one of a robbery gone wrong and therefore of a non premeditated murder. But also the hypothesis of an attack linked to a gang that can not be excluded given the links between the young rapper and the Crips gang. A few hours before his death, the rapper had in any case shared a video on social networks with the exact address of the house where he resided, worth \$ 2.5 million and he rented to the actress Teddi Mellencamp.



What is the new Back to the Future car?

In the Back to the Future franchise, the DeLorean time machine is a time travel device made by retrofitting a DMC DeLorean vehicle with a flux capacitor, which allows for time travel when it hits 88 miles per hour.



Almost four decades and several corporate iterations later, the latest carmaker to bear the DeLorean name is getting closer to launching its highly anticipated electric vehicle.

The DeLorean Motor Company revealed new images and details about the car, the Alpha5.



The DeLorean Alpha5 is set to hit the market in 2024 and might be able to go 88 miles per hour, but it doesn't quite look like the famous time-traveling car from "Back to the Future" (which could bend the space-time continuum at that speed), according to CNN.

1) Fête des lumières:

From Thursday 8 to Sunday 11 December. Opening hours on Thursday and Friday between 8 pm and 12 am. On Saturday between 7 pm and 12 am. On Sunday between 6 pm and 10 pm. It's located in Lyon.

2) La Fête de la musique:

The Fête de la Musique, also known in English as Music Day, Make Music Day or World Music Day,[4] is an annual music celebration that takes place on 21 June. On Music Day, citizens and residents are urged to play music outside in their neighborhoods or in public spaces and parks. Free concerts are also organized, where musicians play for fun and not for payment.

3) Le Tour de France:

The Tour de France is an annual men's multiple-stage bicycle race primarily held in France, while also occasionally passing through nearby countries. It consists of 21 stages, each a day long, over the course of 23 days, coinciding with the Bastille Day holiday. It is the oldest of the Grand Tours and generally considered the most prestigious.

4) 14 juillet, fête nationale:

Bastille Day is the common name given in English-speaking countries to the national day of France, which is celebrated on 14 July each year. The French National Day is the anniversary of the Storming of the Bastille on 14 July 1789, a major event of the French Revolution, as well as the Fête de la Fédération that celebrated the unity of the French people on 14 July 1790. SIMONE VEIL FIGHT TO MAKE ABORTION LEGAL

1970-1973: THE FIGHT FOR THE RIGHT TO ABORTION TAKES A NEW TURN

On February 1st 2023, this bill was considered and adopted at first reading by the senate with 166 votes in favour, 152 against and 23 abstentions.

The bill, as voted by the senate, provides for the addition of a paragraph to section 34 of the Constitution "the law shall determine the conditions under which a woman's freedom to terminate her pregnancy is exercised."

The bill having not been voted in the same terms by the two national assemblies then in the senate for a second reading before being submitted to referendum by the president of the republic then approved by the French.

Registration of the right to abortion in the french constitution

A proposal for a constitutional law aimed at protecting and guaranteeing the fundamental right to abortion would prohibit the legislator from abolishing abortion or seriously impairing.

It would be enshrined in the 1958 constitution "the freedom of a woman to terminate her pregnancy".

This proposal was made due to the regression of the right to abortion in the United States, Poland and Hungary.


On October 7th, 2022, this proposal was tabled in Parliament by the deputy, Mathilde Panot and several of her colleagues. The National Assembly adopted it at first reading with modification on 24 November 2022 by 337 votes in favour, 32 against and 18 absentees.

A compromise amendment made it possible to draft the text differently and to have it adopted by the senators, while in a recent past they opposed the entry of the right to abortion in the constitution. The author of this amendment is Philippe Bas, former collaborator of Simone Veil.

Kara is an Android produced by the company Cyberlife. The AX400 model is used to manage and maintain the house, a domestic employee in short. One day, Todd Williams comes to pick up Kara in a Cyberlife store, which was being repaired after a traffic accident. Having lost her memory, Kara rediscovers the incalculable place where Todd and his young daughter Alice live, who seems to avoid any contact.

Becoming deviant or deviance is a phenomenon where androids deviate from their programmed behavior. They have left their owners and gone astray.



Connor is one of three playable characters in Detroit: Become Human. He is an android model RK800, built as an advanced prototype by Cyberlife, he is designed to assist human law enforcement, especially in the investigation of deviant android cases. Sent to the Detroit Police Department, Connor was assigned to work with Lieutenant Hank Anderson. Throughout their investigation, Connor may make discoveries about cases, himself, and become a decisive agent in turning events around.



BECOME A DEVIANT REMAIN A MACHINE

WORLD TRADE CENTER



The twin towers in New York were virtually identical. They were located on Manhattan Island. Specifically in the World Trade Center. The tallest towers in the world when they were built in 1973. They were destroyed due to a terrorist attack.

The attacks of September 11, 2001 were four Islamist suicide attacks perpetrated on the same day in the United States and causing the death of 2,977 people. In the center of Manhattan in New York, in Arlington in Virginia and in Shanksville in Pennsylvania, in less than two hours, between 8:14 a.m. and 10:03 a.m. They are carried out by members of the jihadist network Al-Qaeda. Nineteen terrorists hijack four airliners

On September 11, 2001, at around 9 a.m., an American Airlines Boeing 767 crashed into the north tower of the World Trade Center, between the 93rd and 99th floors. In the tower, three emergency stairwells are severed, trapping hundreds of people. Flames shoot from the building. On the plane, there were 81 passengers and 11 crew members. Among them, five terrorists.

A few minutes later. The second tower of the World Trade Center was hit by the Boeing 767, on board 56 passengers and 9 crew members hit the South Tower, at 950 km/h, between the 77th and 85th floors.

In the Manhattan district, a little more than 10 minutes later, the twin towers catch fire. Thick clouds of smoke and dust form. Rescuers flocked, massively, near the scene and tried to evacuate the employees.



Stuck in the towers, many people call the emergency services and their relatives, in order to understand what is happening. Many are suffocating. World Trade Center tower workers jump out of building windows. An act of desperation and resignation, to escape the flames.

Nearly an hour after being hit by the second plane, the south tower collapsed. 30 minutes later, the north tower of the World Trade Center imitates its twin, and collapses. Clouds of dust cover Manhattan. Then the mayor of New York asks for the evacuation of the streets of Manhattan. Passersby run and flee, by the thousands.

In total, nearly 3,000 people lost their lives in the attacks of September 11, 2001 and 6,200 were injured. Among the victims are about 500 firefighters and rescue workers who intervened. Many Americans have since suffered numerous sequelae, such as cancers, linked to the breathing of toxic dust. These attacks are the deadliest the world has ever seen.



JDB in Bangladesh



Hello M.Julien and thank you for telling us about your trip.

- Where did you go and were you alone ?

So, no, I was not alone. I did the trip with 2 colleagues : M.Hadjukiewicz and M.Vieville.

We went to Bangladesh, a small country next to India.



- Did this trip go well ?

Everything was ok during the trip. But we saw very poor people during our trip. We noticed that people had many difficulties because of money, problems with drinking water...

- Why did you choose this destination ?

We have a project with students here in Jean de Berry, to create a PSF (Pond Sand Filter) for the population in a small town in Bangladesh for safe drinking water. It's part of a project in our school with some colleagues.



- Did you have a specific goal ?

Yes, the first goal was to see small towns which have no PSF. And with some students and my colleagues, we hope to create a PSF for one of these towns.

- How long did your trip last ?

About 10 or 11 days, and a lot of hours on the plane !

- What are the cultural differences to consider ?

You know between France and Bangladesh, it's like 2 different worlds. We are European people, with our culture, the food, the songs, religion too... And Bangladesh is a very different country, there are many people, a lot of pollution, a lot of poor people too and the culture is very different. People there are muslims or hindus... so it's like discovering a new world ! Very different !



- What places have you been able to visit ?

We visited different cities and some small towns so the biggest city was Dhaka, the capital in Bangladesh.

Another city in Savar which is the place where we lived with the GK association. And other towns, sorry, I forgot the names... And yes ! We visited a very big area with the Padma River near India, and the name of this big area is the Sundarbans.

- And what was your favourite place ?

Ah ! I think, the Sundarbans was my favourite because we saw a lot of animals (some monkey), beautiful nature. Unfortunately, we could not see Bengal tigers... But this was a very beautiful area, peaceful with a lot of nature.

- What was the best time of your trip ?

I think the best time is a day during which we visited some schools and for the first time we met students. And this was a very beautiful meeting because all the students had a lot of questions, they were very curious about us, France... And one funny thing is that when you ask these students what do they know about France, they reply : « Kylian Mbappé ! ».

- What positive aspects from the life there would you like to find in France ?

It's a little bit difficult to answer because we are really 2 different worlds, ok... But, in fact, we are very lucky to live in France because of the health care, the schools, food – we have everything we need or want in France. But in Bangladesh, it is very difficult for many things. For example, the road. Driving there, ok ? Just between 2 cities, 20 kilometers, it's like one or 2 hours drive ! In France, in your car, it would take about 15 / 20 minutes !

Holi, the Festival of colours



Hello Vaishnavi! Nice to have you again in our magazine!

-Hello! Thank you so much for having me. It's always a pleasure.

I heard that there is a big festival in India in March. Please, could you tell us about it?

First, when does it take place exactly and why?

-India is known for its different festivals all around the year, one of which is Holi, also called festival of colors.

This festival is celebrated generally in the month of March or at the beginning of spring season. There can be various reasons for celebration of Holi but mostly it signifies the different colours of spring or to mark a good harvest for the farmers.

While I am more interested in tasting traditional dishes made by my mother and granny. On the day of playing with colours everyone normally wears white clothes. We do not decorate the house as such.

Is it an old festival? When did it first start in India?

-Holi is truly a very ancient festival of India. Records show that it dates back as far as 4th century C.E.

Do you know if it is celebrated in other countries in the world?

-This festival is widely celebrated in India but also it has gained popularity in western countries like the US and UK.
